
April/May 2014 Meadowlands Survey Results

- 39 households out of a possible 98 households completed the survey: 40% response rate
- Survey was deployed during the months of April and May, 2014
- Respondents submitted their surveys via the dropbox on Sylvan, via email, and by personally handing it in during the May 2 community meeting or to one of the Meadowlands Advisory Group (MAG) members

- When asked to rank all the governance options outlined on the survey where 1 = the option a household would <u>MOST</u> like to pursue and 5 = option that a household would <u>LEAST</u> like to purse, the following results were obtained (note that not everyone ranked every item):



The data show that the top two governance options selected were: RESIDENTS TAKE OVER MANAGEMENT AND DAY-TO-DAY OPERATION OF THE MEADOW LAND PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION (MLPOA) (12 votes for #1) and ELECT AN ADVISORY COUNCIL TO PRESENT ISSUES AND REQUESTS TO THE MLPOA BOARD (11 votes for #1). On the other hand, the least popular choice was THE NEIGHBORHOOD BECOMES PART OF MONONGALIA COUNTY (21 votes for the #5 choice).

2. When asked, *"If we do not form a Homeowners Association, would you be willing to contribute to a general fund for road maintenance?"* – respondents answered:

YES:	28
NO:	6
MAYBE:	2
LEFT QUESTION BLANK:	3

- 3. Those 28 households willing to contribute said they would give anywhere from "personal choice" or "depends" to \$750/yr. The average amount actually given was \$280/year.
- 4. Six people said they were an attorney, engineer, accountant or a contractor AND they would be willing to assist in areas of their expertise.
- 5. When asked to state the top three concerns / desires they had with regards to our community, the main issues that surfaced were as follows:
 - 30 household mentioned ROAD REPAIR/MAINTENANCE needs
 - 16 mentioned SNOW ISSUES
 - 12 comments were about BEAUTIFICATION (e.g., of the entrance to our community)
 - 8 comments were about the SCHOOL BUS situation
 - 5 comments were about SAFETY in general (e.g., having a neighborhood watch; working street lights; speed limit)
